

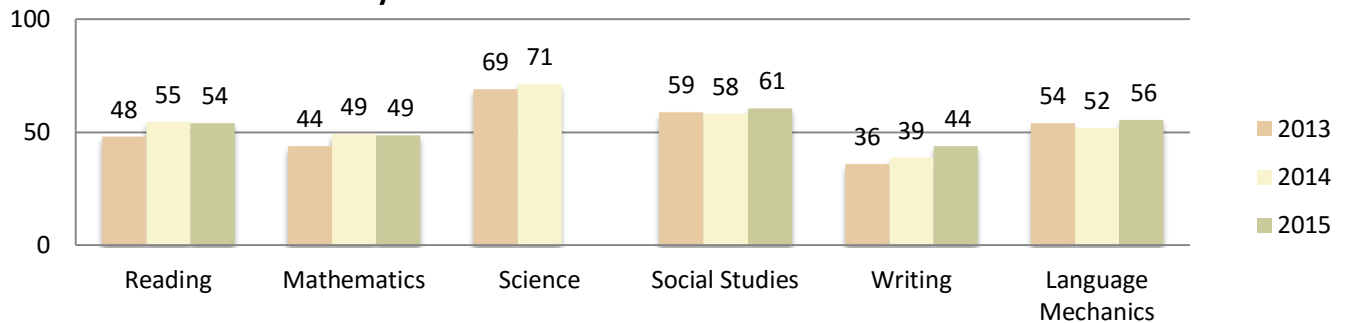
Results for All Students

Kentucky is committed to giving each and every student a full opportunity to reach the high levels of achievement that will prepare them for adult success. Under 2009's Senate Bill 1, Kentucky has adopted new standards focused on college and career readiness and benchmarked to international expectations. In 2012, Kentucky began assessing students against those higher standards, and the first two years of results are shown below. These results are challenging, showing that most students are currently not achieving at the needed levels and that we will need to make deep, thoughtful changes in our schools to change those outcomes.

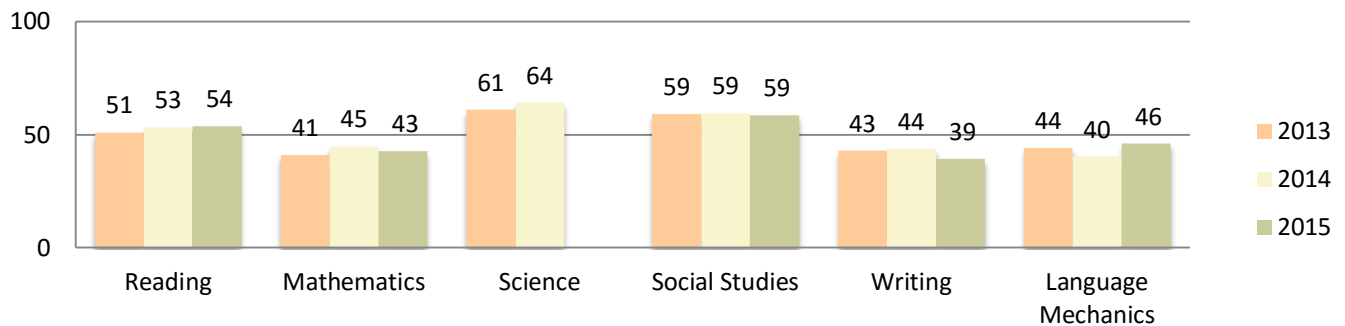

Elementary School Statewide Percent Proficient or Above



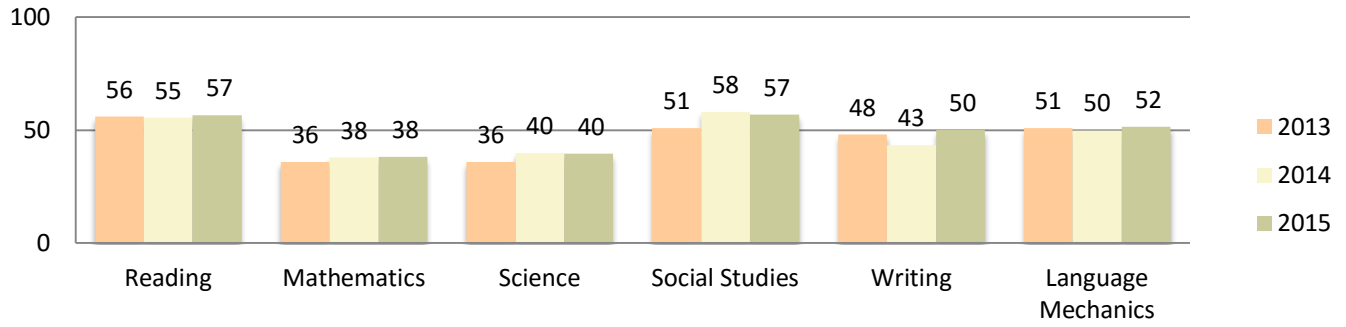
Middle School Statewide Percent Proficient or Above
